



Convention Policies

Attending a Con is about one thing - fun! Fanboy wants you to have as much fun as humanly possible. For that fun, positive environment, Fanboy Expo has a few expectations to ensure *everyone* can have their version of fun. Understanding and abiding by these expectations is expected

Airspace (Balloons, Drones, etc.)

Much like a government facility that may or may not exist in the Nevada desert, Fanboy Expo is a No-Fly Zone. There shouldn't be any tethering or launching of any sort of craft before, during, or after the show within any space occupied by official programming.

Badges/Wristbands

You've got it, flaunt it! We want the world to know that you're here to have fun at Fanboy Expo! Furthermore, you need it to access, ya know, anything thats sponsored by us. Keep your wristband or badge on and visible at all times. If for whatever reason your waterproof, fireproof (please do not test this claim), tear-proof wristband becomes unattached to your wrist, bring back at least 51% of it and we'll affix a new one - complimentary!

Bag Check/Backpacks

In light of recent events around the world we are instituting a Bag Check Policy at Fanboy Events. These bag checks will be performed at random by security personnel to ensure all contraband (detailed below) are left at home. Furthermore, any bag larger than an average, backpack shall be checked for pick up later on the Main Concourse. If your medical needs require you to have certain things on your person at all times, please consider switching to a fanny-pack or small, drawstring backpack.

Code of Conduct

Attendees must respect common sense rules for public behavior, personal interaction, common courtesy, and respect for private property. Harassing or offensive behavior will not be tolerated. Fanboy Expo reserves the right to revoke, without refund, the badge/wristband of any attendee not in compliance with this policy. Persons finding themselves in a situation where they feel their safety is at risk or who become aware of an attendee not in compliance with this policy should immediately locate the nearest member of security, or staff member, so that the matter can be handled in an expeditious manner.

Costume Weapons Policy

No functional weapons are allowed at Fanboy Expo (yes, even if you have a permit).

Simulated or costume weapons are allowed as a part of your costume, subject to prior approval by security and compliance with the following:

- All costume weapons/props must be inspected
- All costume weapons/props must conform to state and federal law.
- Projectile costume weapons must be rendered inoperable.
- Functional (real) arrows must have their tips removed and be bundled and zip tied to a quiver
- Costume swords must be tied to your costume in such a way that they can't be drawn.
- After each person's costume weapon has been checked, it will be tagged by security, and you will be given a wristband to wear to designate that your weapons have been checked.
- Security will escort you to the security station for inspection if your costume weapon is not tagged.

If you do not want to have your costume weapons inspected or tagged, or if you are not willing to comply with these policies, please do not bring your costume weapons to Fanboy Expo.

Google Glass/Video Recorders/Camera Phones

Remember recording of footage on the screens during panels is prohibited (see below: No Video or Audio Recording of Movie and TV Panels). This includes Google Glass. You cannot wear Google Glasses during footage viewing in any program room. If your Google Glass are prescription, please bring a different pair of glasses to use during these times.

Also, please turn off your devices (phones, tablets, laptops, etc.) screens and put them away during the screening of panel footage. Not doing so interferes with everyone's viewing quality and causes security to think you're recording the clip.

No Handcarts, Trolleys, Rolling Luggage, or Oversized Strollers in the Exhibit Hall

Please be aware that, due to safety reasons, no handcarts, trolleys, rolling luggage, or oversized strollers are allowed in the Exhibit Hall. Attendees found on the exhibit floor with these items will be removed the show.

No Paging

Please keep in mind that there will be no personal pages over the P. A. system. Set a time and place to meet with your family and friends and communicate with them via text or phone when necessary. There is also a message board available at Fanboy Expo in Lobby C, where you can post written messages.

No Pets Allowed

If you have pets, including iguanas, parrots, boa constrictors, or other nonhuman critters, please leave them at home. The Convention Center will not allow animals into the building, except for service animals.

No Selfie Sticks and Similar Devices at Fanboy Expo

Selfie sticks, GoPro poles, or any device that extends your camera or phone away from your hand, are not allowed at Fanboy Expo. If you're seen with one of these devices, you will be asked by security to put it away and not use it at Fanboy Expo. This is applicable during all official programming throughout the event weekend.

No Sitting in Exhibit Hall Aisles

By order of the fire marshal, sitting in the Exhibit Hall aisles is not allowed. Lounges are located throughout the Convention Center and near concessions for your convenience.

No Smoking, Including E-cigarettes and Vaping Products and Devices

No smoking is allowed at any Convention event at any time and in any location. No smoking at Fanboy Expo includes traditional cigarettes, pipes, cigars, plus E-cigarettes and any vaping product or device. This policy includes the Exhibit Hall, all the Programming Rooms, the Convention-sponsored parties, and the after party. You are welcome to step outside to smoke in designated smoking areas only, but please be considerate of others when you do. This policy is in place not only for the comfort of attendees but also to comply with city ordinances. Please comply with this policy; noncompliance may result in being ejected from the convention.

No Strollers Allowed in the Programming Rooms

By order of the fire marshal, strollers are not allowed in any of the programming rooms. Stroller parking is located in various areas in the Convention Center. Parking will be free of charge and provided on a first-come, first-serve basis. Please note: Fanboy Expo will not provide security or check-in/check-out for the strollers.

No Video or Audio Recording of Movie and TV Panels

No video or audio recording of the footage on the screen during movie and television panels is allowed. The footage shown on these panels are exclusives brought to us by the studios and networks. Please respect their rights and allow us to continue to show this type of material to our attendees.
